Has Frank de Boer's first season with Atlanta United been a success?

Ultimately, sports are result-driven. There's no ambiguity, or so it goes.

Except success, on a macro sense, isn't binary. FC Dallas finishing seventh place this season and making the Audi 2019 MLS Cup Playoffs is a success given their circumstance; If LAFC had done the same, it wouldn't have been quite as well received. Life is all about managing expectations, after all. Every game offers a micro success/failure dichotomy, but the season as a whole isn't quite as simple. And it doesn't happen over 90 minutes.

That (surprisingly brief) preamble brings us to the question at hand: Has it been a successful first season for Frank de Boer with Atlanta United? Well, it's complicated.

De Boer, one of the Netherlands' best-ever players, came to Atlanta after mixed results in his first three managerial gigs. He had resounding success with Ajax but not quite the same in short stints with Inter Milan and Crystal Palace. He had a tough act to follow after Tata Martino left the club with MLS Cup as his lasting memory. You never want to be the guy after The Guy.



Despite taking over the reigning champs with the reigning Landon Donovan MLS MVP, the job wasn't an uncomplicated one.

Atlanta started slow, failing to reach their pyrotechnic heights of 2018 led by Miguel Almiron and Josef Martinez. Pity Martinez didn't quite settle in quickly and was unable to reach Almiron's MVP-finalist form as his replacement. Meanwhile Ezequiel Barco's growth didn't get a great chance to consistently manifest itself in an Atlanta kit, with the U-20 World Cup as well as a few injuries along the way.

The team didn't make a deep Concacaf Champions League run as hoped, but it didn't metastasize and spoil the season in the same way as complications from the competition has, in part, hampered Toronto FC in 2018 then Sporting KC this year. The continental adventure left De Boer with a shortened preseason and limited meaningful training sessions at the beginning of the season, too.

Often he urged fans to allow some time to pass before arriving at judgments. Installing a new system, from a new coach, takes time.

After the slow start, Atlanta began to find their groove after a pair of formation changes. From essentially a back five at the season's start, to a traditional back four, then a more aggressive back three, the club were beginning to stretch into their vast potential.

Atlanta began to excel back on the front foot, satiating both players and fans alike. It came just in time, accentuating the club's U.S. Open Cup run, culminating with a 2-1 triumph in the final over Minnesota United, as well as a Campeones Cup victory, beating Mexican giants Club America. It wasn't the CCL, but it was a trophy both the MLS champs and Liga MX's best sought to win.

All the while, breakout star Miles Robinson anchored the team defense as he went from a backup on his club to a national team-level defender. Darlington Nagbe had one of his best seasons in the league under De Boer. He helped turn winger Justin Meram into a solid left wingback, another player benefitting from a change of scenery and a new coaching staff.

A season which has delivered two trophies (so far), second place in the Eastern Conference in a season which saw

Almiron depart and Barco often unavailable, sounds quite good. It's not the whole story, though. For all the club's perceived defensive improvements, the team only conceded one fewer goal in 2019 than 2018. There were some publicly aired frustrations, from Leandro Gonzalez Pirez and others around the All-Star Game. There was the frustration of Pity Martinez, which was also very public. Atlanta gained 11 fewer regular-season points in 2019 than last year.

After Atlanta began to hit top form, they played themselves within a chance to pull back toward the top slot in the conference again. Instead, they capitulated at Yankee Stadium against NYCFC for a thoroughly disheartening 4-1 loss. Brad Guzan gave voice to the club's mentality, citing their lack of points gained from losing positions (2), which was only better than FC Cincinnati in the league. The teams directly above, NYCFC (25), and below, Philadelphia (18) were two of the top four teams in that stat.

Where does all that leave De Boer's debut season on the Atlanta United bench? Through the regular season, as well as three cup competitions, the verdict is still out.

The playoff run will have a huge say in de Boer's season, given this club strives for MLS Cup every season, however unfair it may be to pin a good portion of success/failure to the small sample size crapshoot that is a single-elimination playoff format. But, hey, the game is the game.

One thing is binary; Atlanta United are about winning trophies. De Boer already has two and is eyeing a third.

Former Real Madrid boss Santiago Solari could be next Orlando City coach

It's been five days since Orlando City SC parted ways with James O'Connor as head coach, and there already could be a replacement in the works.

The Lions and Argentine manager Santiago Solari are in advanced talks, according to AS. Solari, 43, recently coached at La Liga superclub Real Madrid after working up their youth ranks in a managerial role.

During his playing days, Solari's made stops at Argentine clubs River Plate and San Lorenzo; Spanish sides Atletico Madrid and Real Madrid; and Italian club Inter Milan, among others.

Should Solari take over Orlando City, he'd become their fourth permanent head coach since entering MLS in 2015. Adrian Heath, Jason Kreis and O'Connor have all led the club, while Bobby Murphy served as interim coach after Heath and Kreis were both let go.

Orlando began MLS play in 2015 as an expansion team alongside New York City FC, but is yet to make the playoffs. This next move will prove vital in changing that, as Luiz Muzzi continues to shape the Eastern Conference side as Executive Vice President of Soccer Operations.

In the last year, MLS has seen a growing wave of international managers join the league. Frank de Boer now leads defending MLS Cup champions Atlanta United, Guillermo Barros Schelotto marshals the LA Galaxy, Ron Jans was hired at FC Cincinnati and Matias Almeyda took over the San Jose Earthquakes.

Could Solari be next?

Borjan implores fans to support Canada in massive US showdown at BMO Field

Canadian national team goalkeeper Milan Borjan had a message to send.

Speaking after Canada's 6-0 thumping of Cuba on September 7 at BMO Field, a match that kicked off their Concacaf Nations League group stage in style, the Red Star Belgrade stalwart was not happy.

"A lot of people don't believe in this team," said Borjan. "You could see that with the fans today: 10,000 only, with Canada playing. With all these young guys, with a lot of future in them, playing in big clubs. It's too bad we don't have enough fans to fill the whole stadium."

The official attendance for that match was 10,224. With the visit of the United States on Tuesday to Toronto, Borjan & Co. are hopeful that the fans will be there to greet them.

"It's crucial," said CanMNT coach John Herdman. "But more for the fans to come along and be part of something really meaningful."

A Canadian Soccer Association spokesperson told MLSsoccer.com that around 15,000 tickets have been sold for the match on Tuesday thus far. The supporters' section is almost all sold out. BMO Field's current capacity sits around 30,000 after renovations, with the previous capacity being 21,556.

The largest attendance for a men's national team game at BMO Field was back in 2008 when 21,978 watched Canada draw 1-1 with Jamaica in World Cup Qualification. That mark was approached in September 2017, again against Jamaica, when the Reggae Boyz came to Toronto for a friendly with the Canadians winning 2-0.

The last ten matches at BMO Field, stretching back to June 2012, have had an average attendance of 14,292. They included five World Cup qualifiers, two friendlies, and one each of Gold Cup, Concacaf Nations League qualification and Concacaf Nations League matches.

"It's not a friendly match, not something that we're just walking up together, playing six subs, that means nothing at the end of it," This means a lot our country, to football in our country," stressed Herdman. "The 17 [FIFA World Rankings] points we could take from this game could really push us into the Hexagonal where, if we get into the Hex, we bring more meaningful, top-quality games back to Canada and test these boys even more."

The top six sides in the region, based on the June 2020 FIFA rankings, will enter the Hex for World Cup qualification next year, competing for the three full Concacaf spots in Qatar come 2022. The rest will undertake a grueling journey with the dim light of the region's half-spot long in the distance.

"Your fans are everything," Herdman said. "Every time we go away – you go into St. Kitts and they're doing everything they can to make sure that Canada feels uncomfortable and their team is given a chance, that extra that fans will bring."

A rocking, packed BMO Field has propelled its team to success before.

"I see how passionate the fans were in the games we've had and I've seen how passionate the Toronto FC fans are here. They certainly, in that [MLS Cup] championship run, made a difference," noted Herdman. "We're hoping everyone comes out and pushes these boys over the line."

"And it's going to need a big push," he added. "If you look at our track record, it's 1985 since we beat this team. Yeah, we've got talent, but we've had talent in previous teams as well. We've come close, but I think the fans could make that bit of difference and we'd love them to be there."

Canada would follow up that September win with a second one days later, 1-0 away to the Cubans in the Cayman Islands. With six points from their first two matches, it is expected that progression to the knockout stage, the Nations League final Championships, will come down to Tuesday's home match against the Americans and the return leg in



Florida in November.

"We've got to get the support," implored Borjan. "These guys, they fight for this country, they come a lot of kilometers to be here, to play these games, to win and to bring Canada to the World Cup. This is very disappointing, for the people not coming to support us.

"As a team, we're going to continue winning, continue bringing good football here," he added. "And I hope, in the future, the stadium will be full." Portland: Oct. 19 at Real Salt Lake, 10 pm ET (ESPNNews, ESPN Deportes) | Round One, Audi 2019 MLS Cup Playoffs

Steffen to start vs. Canada, but Berhalter mum on other USMNT lineup decisions

Gregg Berhalter has some decisions to make before kickoff.

The US men's national team trained at BMO Field on Monday afternoon ahead of their Tuesday night Concacaf Nations League clash with Canada as the two battle for supremacy in League A, Group A (7:30 pm ET | ESPN2 in US; OneSoccer in Canada).

The USMNT head coach made it clear, ahead of Friday's 7-0 win over Cuba, that Josh Sargent would get the starting nod ahead of Gyasi Zardes, but he was in no such revelatory mood ahead of the bigger of the two games for the Americans.



"We're working through that now," said Berhalter of who would lead the line. "We'll do training today, see how everyone has come out of the game."

"Josh picked up a little bit of an ankle [knock]," added the coach. "We're going to keep assessing him, see where he's at. But whether it's Josh or Gyasi or whoever, we're comfortable with who we have as options."

Though each has a slightly different profile, who starts at striker doesn't completely change what the US is about, according to Michael Bradley.

"They're obviously different players, they both bring different things to the table, but in the grand scheme of things, what Gregg asks of them [doesn't change] completely," said Bradley, who will make a homecom-

ing of sorts at BMO Field.

"As players we all have different characteristics, all have different qualities, everybody is going to step on the field and interpret a role and a job in a different way, but the mentality of the team, the attempt at what we're trying to do, doesn't change whether Josh or Gyasi is on the field," continued the Toronto FC midfielder. "They're both excellent players, their ability to score goals, to bring others into the game, they both work for the team, so we're lucky to have them both. And we still have Jozy [Altidore], who is not with us at the moment."

Berhalter concurred: "Without going too much into it they have different skill sets, but we can take advantage of both and that's the nice thing."

"I talk about player profiles and how we look for different profiles because it gives the team different size, different ways to attack," he added. "Either of them on the field sets us up a little bit differently."

One of the other questions looming is whether Bradley gets the starting nod at his home pitch.

Berhalter made it clear that in a competitive match there was no room for sentimentality to play a role in his decision making: "I don't think that's what we're trying to achieve here. We're trying to put a team on the field that is going to win the game."

He did unveil one selection: Zack Steffen, who came into camp with a knock, will be the goalkeeper after Brad Guzan started against Cuba.

"Zack's fine," said Berhalter. "He'll play tomorrow."

Cómo esta el historial de Colombia frente a selecciones africanas?

El cuadro cafetero jugará este martes ante Argelia su vigésimo encuentro contra un equipo del continente africano. La Selección Colombia seguirá su preparación de cara a la Copa América y la Eliminatoria Sudamericana rumbo a Qatar 2022 con el amistoso ante su similar de Argelia este martes en Lille, Francia.

No será la primera vez que el combinado cafetero se enfrente a un seleccionado africano, en total ha disputado 19 duelos previos contando amistosos y oficiales, aunque será el primer cruce con Argelia.

El Goal repasamos el historial de Colombia ante Selecciones de África.

El primer enfrentamiento se dio hace casi 30 años ante Egipto, previo al Mundial de Italia 90, fue empate 1-1 para el equipo de Pacho Maturana. Desde entonces ha jugado contra Liberia, Sudáfrica, Marruecos, Senegal, Camerún, Túnez y Nigeria, siendo éste al que más veces ha enfrentado (4).

En total Colombia ha jugado 14 amistosos con africanos, logrando 8 victorias, cinco empates y una sola derrota (2-1 ante Sudáfrica previo al Mundial de 2010).



El último cruce data de 2018, precisamente ante Egipto, también con empate (0-0), como preparación para la Copa Mundo de Rusia 2018.

OFICIALES (COPA MUNDO Y CONFEDERACIONES)

Colombia ha estado ligado al continente africano en la mayoría de sus participaciones en eventos orbitales. En sus últimas presentaciones en la Copa Mundo siempre ha enfrentado una selección de este continente. En Italia 90 perdió 2-1 ante Camerún, partido inolvidable por el histórico error de Higuita; en Francia 98 venció a 1-0 Túnez, logrando su única victoria y gol del certamen; en Brasil 2014 se impuso 2-0 contra Costa de Marfil con goles de James Rodríguez y Juanfer Quintero; y en Rusia 2018 venció por la mínima a Senegal, victoria que selló la clasificación a segunda ronda.

Además, la Tricolor también se midió a Camerún en el marco de la Copa Confederaciones 2003, a la que llegó como campeón de América. El equipo cafetero clasificó a las semifinales y allí perdió 1-0 ante el cuadro de los Leones indomables. Ese partido quedó en la memoria por la trágica muerte de Marc Vivien-Foe.

NÚMEROS GENERALES

Colombia ha enfrentado en total 19 veces a selecciones africanas, con un saldo ampliamente positivo: 11 victorias, cinco empates y solo tres derrotas, para un efectividad del 66%; además la Tricolor marcó 27 goles y recibió 12.

Cabe resaltar que el combinado cafetero no pierde ante un rival del continente negro desde 2010. Fue 2-1 en el amistoso ante Sudáfrica previo al Mundial; dicha selección la dirigía el Bolillo Gómez; de ese equipo solo se mantiene en la plantilla David Ospina.

Púgiles de México y Dominicana se enfrentarán en pelea de Wilfredo "Bimbitito" Méndez

Púgiles de México y la República Dominicana pelearán en Puerto Rico el próximo 26 de octubre, como parte de la cartelera en la que el puertorriqueño Wilfredo "Bimbitito" Méndez defenderá por primera vez su título mínimo de la Organización Mundial de Boxeo (OMB), se informó este lunes.

Por ello, y según detalló la compañía promotora PR Best Boxing Promotions en un comunicado de prensa, el dominicano Félix Díaz (20-3, 10 kos), medallista de oro en los Juegos Olímpicos de Pekín'08, se medirá al mexicano Darío Fermán (18-6, 15 kos) a 10 asaltos y en 147 libras (67 kilos).

Asimismo, el dominicano Yenifel Vicente (35-4-2, 27 kos) peleará ante el mexicano Víctor Ruiz (23-10, 16 kos) en 122 libras (55 kilos) a diez asaltos, mientras que a seis asaltos lo hará el puertorriqueño John Correa (6-0, 5 kos) contra el mexicano Edgardo Velázquez (12-0, 12 kos) en las 154 libras (70 kilos).



Igualmente, el dominicano Freny Fortunato (7-0, 6 kos) se enfrentará al mexicano Marcos Muñiz (14-0, 11 kos) en las 122 libras (55 kilos) a ocho asaltos.

Por otra parte, los invictos puertorriqueños Patrick Cora (8-0, 6 kos) y Luis Midyael Sánchez (8-0, 6 kos) se enfrentarán a ocho asaltos en las 154 libras (70 kilos).

La pelea entre el puertorriqueño Méndez (14-1, 5 kos) frente al colombiano Gabriel Mendoza (30-6-2, 23 kos) será la estelar para la cartelera que se llevará a cabo en el Coliseo Rubén Zayas Montañez de Trujillo Alto, municipio vecino a San Juan.

Méndez se convirtió en campeón mínimo de la OMB el pasado 25 de agosto al derrotar por decisión unánime en 12 asaltos al filipino Vic Saludar, en cartel celebrado en San Juan.

Los jueces dieron ganador a Méndez con unas anotaciones de 117-110, 115-112 y 116-111 frente a Saludar.

El combate fue la pelea estelar de la velada organizada por el Casino Metro Boxing Nights en el Centro de Convenciones de la capital, evento que contó con la presencia del excampeón panameño Roberto "Mano de piedra" Durán, que colgó los guantes en 2001 en una pelea ante el puertorriqueño Héctor "El Macho" Camacho.

Cristiano Ronaldo anotó el gol 700 en su carrera

El portugués Cristiano Ronaldo agrandó aún más su leyenda tras marcar este lunes ante Ucrania el gol número 700 en su carrera profesional, en la que ha pasado por los clubes Sporting, Manchester United, Real Madrid y Juventus.

El esperado tanto lo anotó de penalti en el minuto 72 durante el partido en Kiev de la fase de clasificación para la Euro-copa 2020.

Un nuevo récord que supone su gol número 95 con el combinado de las "quinas", al que hay que sumarle otros muchos logros, como el Puskas en 2009 o sus cuatro Botas de Oro.

En dos partidos de Liga anotó cinco goles y con el de hoy su próximo objetivo será el de superar el récord del iraní Ali Daei, que marcó 109 goles en 149 partidos.

Con 34 años, Ronaldo tiene en el horizonte el sorprendente récord del iraní Ali Daei, que jugó hasta los 38 años y fijó la máxima anotación de un jugador con el combinado de su país en 109 tantos.

Tras su paso por el Sporting de Portugal y llegar a la capital lisboeta siendo un adolescente procedente de Madeira, Ronaldo marcó con el primer equipo, antes de fichar por el Manchester United, un total de cinco goles.

Con el club inglés anotó 115 goles con una media de 0,40 tantos por partido.

Ya en el Real Madrid, Ronaldo marcó 450 goles en 438 partidos, por lo que tuvo una media de 1,03.

Cain Velasquez se retira de UFC; será luchador

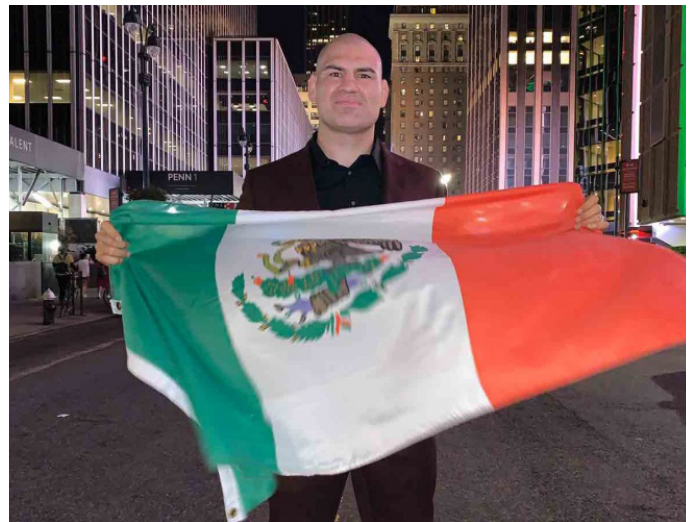

Cain se enfrentará a Brock Lesnar, hombre al que le arrebató el campeonato máximo de la UFC en octubre de 2010, el próximo 31 de octubre en Arabia Saudita.
